Transitional Safety Zone Program

Sobriety is a requirement for entering sober living homes. However, most individuals are released from detox facilities before they are fully detoxed or clean. Our **Transitional Safety Zone Program (TSZ)** offers these individuals a safe space to complete the detox process in a loving, well-equipped house with round-the-clock management, setting them up for a successful recovery.

- Medical Assisted Treatment (MAT)
- Peer Recovery Support
- Case Management
- Acudetox
- Counseling Services
- Relapse Prevention Group
